## Fish Collection Regulations in Mississippi

You need a fishing license to collect fish in Mississippi.

Dipnets are not allowed for the collection of fish in Mississippi. People can only collect with seines that may be no larger than 25 feet in length and 4 feet in depth or with minnow traps that are constructed of glass, plastic, nonmetallic, or wire mesh not more than 32 inches in length and 12 inches in diameter without leads or wings and having an entrance no larger than 1 inch in diameter. All fish native to Mississippi that are not classified as game fish or threatened/endangered fish are classified as either nongame fish or nongame gross fish which can be collected with a minnow seine or in minnow traps. Any game fish or threatened/endangered fish may not be collected with minnow seines or minnow traps.

All fish species in the following families are **game fish** and can only be taken by angling.

- Centrarchidae (Black Basses and Sunfish)
- Percidae (Walleye, Sauger, and **Darters**)
- Esocidae (Pickerels)
- Moronidae (White Basses)

All the following fish species are either threatened or endangered at the state or federal level and may not be taken by any gear.
